GUIDED PRIVATE TOUR OF OSIRIS EXHINITION FOR PRESIDENT HOLLANDE WITH JACK AND LANG COMMENTED BY FRANCK GODDIO------

The exhibition finds its genesis in the underwater archaeological discoveries in Egypt in the west of the Nile Delta, by Franck Goddio and IEASM. The French President Francois Hollande, fan of museums, payed a visit to the Arab World Institute (IMA) to inaugurate the exhibition "Osiris, swallowed mysteries of Egypt. It is indeed, the sixth time he goes there since the beginning of the mandate of President of the Republic. These 250 new works from underwater excavations that are presented, plus more than forty pieces from museums in Cairo and Alexandria, some out of Egypt for the first time.

INTRODUCING ALLOCUTION BY JACK LANG PRĀ%SIDENT OF IMA INSTITUTE OF ARAB WORLD------

As host of the premises, the President of the IMA introduced speeches to present the exhibition Osiris and the steps undertaken that have been effected since the recent decision, when the Suez Canal was inaugurated in Cairo this summer.
